## Congress

- Passes federal laws
- Raises taxes
- Regulates foreign and interstate commerce
- Declares war
- Raises and funds the military
- May borrow money by issuing bonds for sale

## **President**

- Commander-in-chief of the military
- Makes treaties with other countries
- Appoints ambassadors, federal judges,
  Supreme Court justices
- Administers U.S. laws
- Acts as head of state

## **Supreme Court**

- Reviews lower federal court rulings and appeals from state courts that involve federal law or constitutional issues
- Hears cases involving foreign ambassadors as first and final courts
- Rules on disputes between the states
